



Al, Smartphones and Lung Health: Breathless with Excitement Webinar with UCL Faculty of Medical Sciences

How to Prove 1=0, And Other Maths Illusions with Gresham College

These "proofs" reveal some very common logical slips that can go unnoticed when we are trying to prove more plausible statements. And the stakes are high. As Sarah show you, once you have "proved" one false claim, you can prove absolutely any statement at all.
