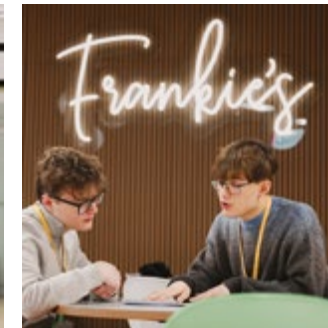

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

STUDENT FINANCIAL SUPPORT FUND

To make life a little easier we offer a range of financial support for eligible students. Those in priority groups can receive a bursary of up to £1,200 per year. This support is available to students who live in a household with an income below £40,000, including most benefits.

If your household income meets the threshold or you received free school meals at secondary school, you may be eligible for a daily meal allowance, which will be credited to your student card. Students who meet the criteria may also receive a travel pass to use on our buses if they live more than one mile from the College. Additionally, this award can also support the cost of educational trips and essential course costs such as printing, textbooks and equipment while studying at Franklin.



MORE INFO

DISCRETIONARY FINANCIAL SUPPORT AWARD

This support is open to students who live in a household with an income below £40,000 (including most benefits). Eligible students can receive a travel pass to use on our buses (if you live more than one mile from the College) and a daily meal allowance.

Additionally, this award also supports the cost of trips and necessary resources while studying at Franklin.

COURSE ENTRY CRITERIA

Depending on your course choices, you'll require slightly different grades. We'll help you choose the best courses for you, plan your next steps, and advise on the grades you'll need for your perfect study programme.

LEVEL 2

3 Year Study Programme

Grade 3 or above in English Language.

Grade 2 or above in Maths.

Plus four other GCSEs or Level 2 vocational equivalents at Grade 3 or above, with at least one Grade 4.

Vocational qualifications such as BTECs may be accepted as an alternative qualification.

LEVEL 3

A Level Programme

5 academic GCSEs, a minimum of 3 x Grade 5s and 2 x Grade 4. These should include English Language and Maths.

Vocational Programme (BTEC/CTEC/AAQ/Diploma/T Level/V Level)

5 GCSEs at Grade 4 or above. These should include English Language. GCSE Maths is required at Grade 3 or above.

Please make sure you check out our individual course entry requirements, as some of our courses require specific grades.

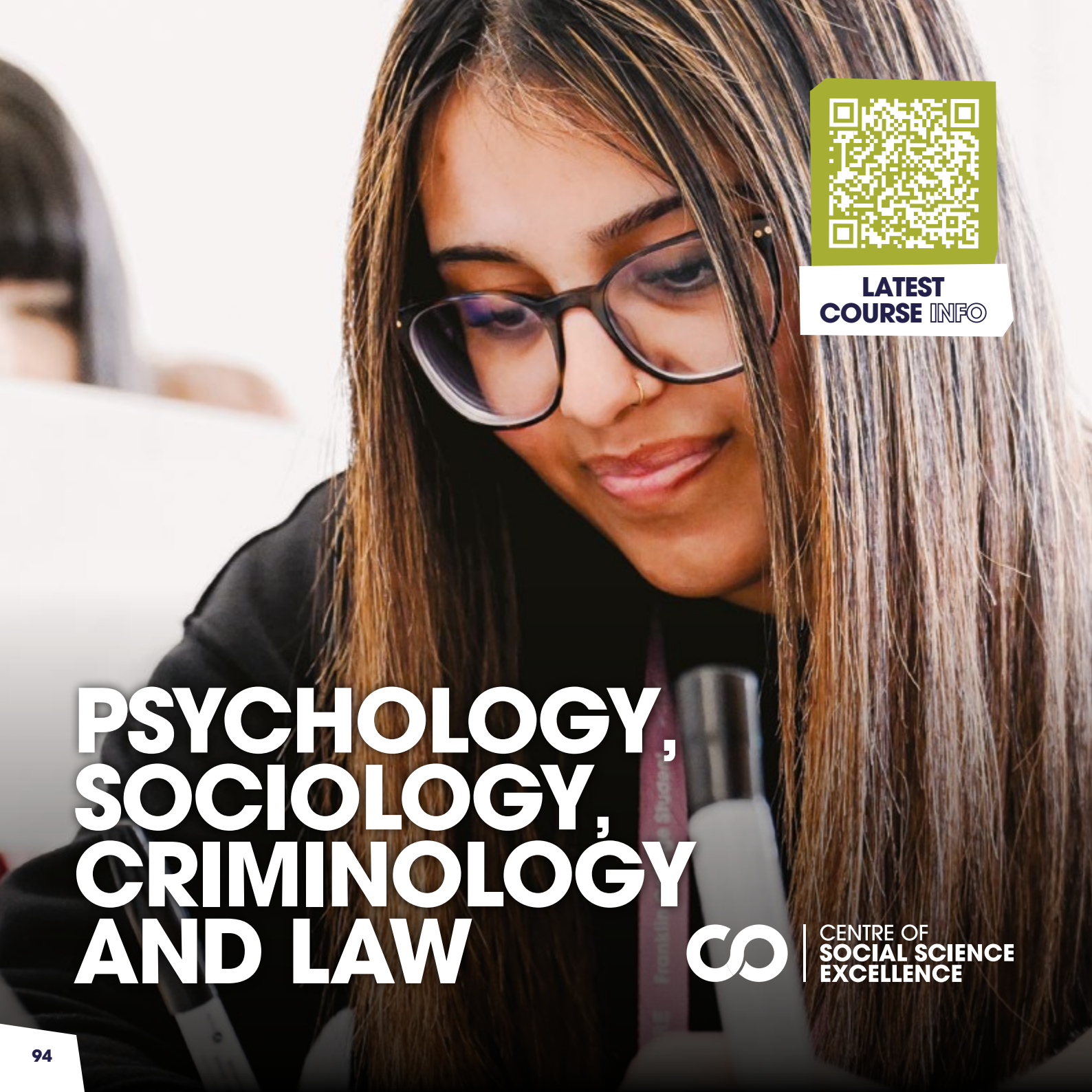
