The Enrichment team are now based in Room 51 (opposite the theatre) – please feel free to pop in if you have any questions!

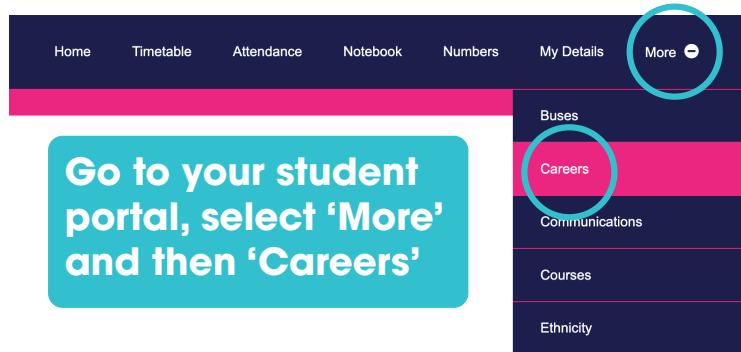
Thrive Monday

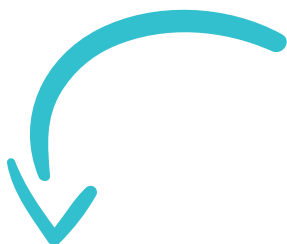

TUI MPL Pilot Cadet Programme 2024
