Youth Action want to hear from you! Between now and the end of October, you have the chance to cast **your** vote on what issue you want to see improved in North East Lincolnshire.


Place your vote here.



### 'Are biologic drugs to treat rheumatoid arthritis harmful in pregnancy?' webinar with UCL Faculty of Medical Sciences

Rheumatoid arthritis affects around 1% of people worldwide, is more common in women and often requires treatment with biologic drugs to control symptoms and prevent joint damage. Many women of child-bearing age with RA treated with biologic drugs plan or become pregnant and it is uncertain, if biologic drugs should be continued throughout pregnancy.

Treatment of RA in pregnancy is important because active arthritis is associated with an increased risk of adverse outcomes and is more likely if biologic drugs are stopped. This talk will discuss whether stopping biologic drugs in pregnancy has harmful effects on disease activity, pregnancy outcomes and/or health of the mother and their children.

### LABOUR MARKET INFORMATION



### What is LMI?

Labour Market Information (LMI) is information that provides insight into the labour markets at different levels (local, regionally or nationally). LMI looks at the industries that are growing and declining and the types and levels of jobs that are increasing and decreasing. LMI is useful to help research future jobs in the local area, understanding the skills needed for certain roles and the demand for future employment.

Each week, we'll be focusing on a different industry and exploring the LMI for that industry.

### **Energy Labour Market Information**

The Energy Sector relates to the production and supply of energy. Renewable energy is generally defined as energy that comes from resources which are naturally replenished on a human timescale such as sunlight, wind, rain, tides, and waves. Renewable energy replaces conventional fuels in four distinct areas, electricity generation, air and water heating/cooling, motor fuels, and rural (off-grid) energy services.

The Energy Sector is very closely linked with engineering, manufacturing, and ports & logistic sectors.

### What opportunities are available?

- Labour demand across the energy and infrastructure sectors will be significant totalling around 760,000 by 2024. This includes 160,000 new jobs and replacing 600,000 due to retirements.
  - There will be a total labour demand of 8.6 million jobs in the UK by 2024
- The offshore wind sector will need to compete against other desirable infrastructure sectors to acquire the 36,000 people that will need to be employed by 2032

### Did you know?

- The Humber is #1 in the UK for biofuel production
- The Grimsby, Sheffield and Hull triangle is the largest energy sector in the UK
- Orsted is the world's leading offshore wind developer, investing £6bn in offshore wind in the Humber
  - Our region has over 20+ onshore windfarms
