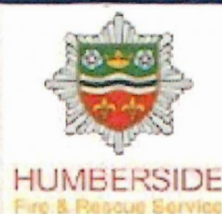

E-SCOOTERS

AND THE LAW

IT IS ILLEGAL...

...to ride an e-scooter on a public road or pavement.

You can only ride an e-scooter on private land, with the land owner's permission.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I'M CAUGHT?

Humberside Police will **seize the e-scooter** and dispose of it, and the rider will also be **liable for prosecution**.



If you cause serious harm to another person whilst riding an e-scooter/e-motorbike, the incident will be investigated in the same way it would if you were riding a motorcycle or driving a car.

If stopped on a public road, pavement or cycle path – the scooter will be seized as part of a nationwide crackdown under **Section 165A of the Road Traffic Act 1988**.

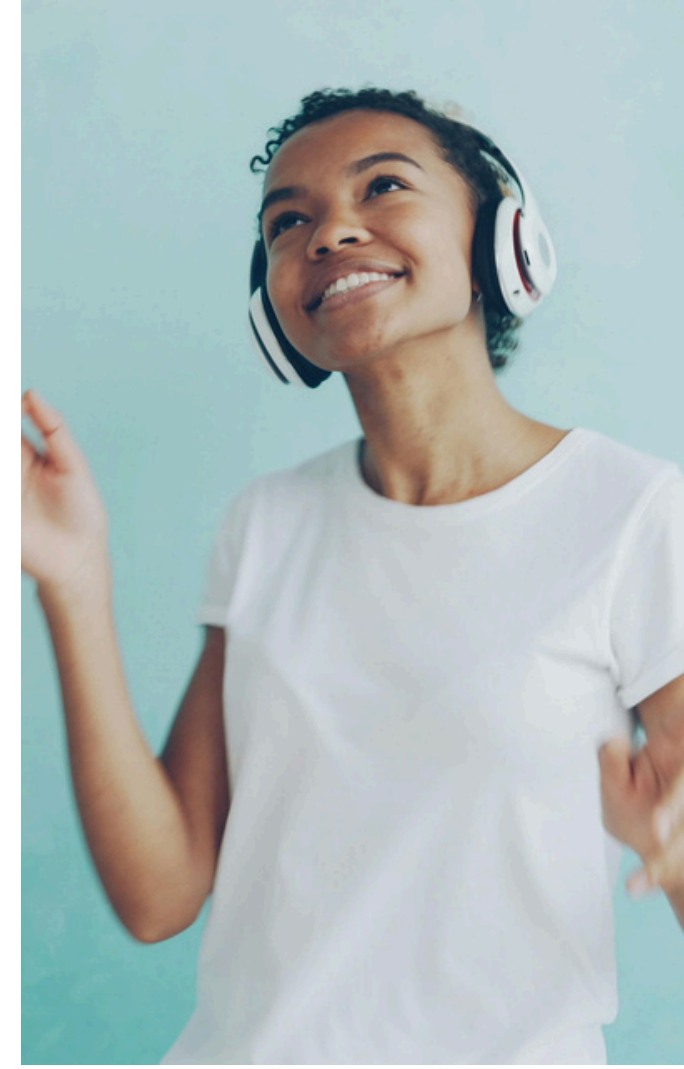
