

Neurodevelopmental Assessments for ASD and ADHD Under 18's

The process for requesting a neurodevelopmental assessment differs depending on the local authority of your GP.

Lincolnshire

If your GP is in Lincolnshire, then you must go through your GP to request a referral for an assessment. Franklin College is unable to make a referral on your behalf. If the GP does put through a referral the college will be contracted by the neuro team to provide observational evidence from an educational setting perspective.

North East Lincolnshire

If your GP is in North East Lincolnshire, then the following process will take place.

1. You will need to book an appointment with reception to see the Wellbeing and Inclusion Co-ordinator to complete a pre-referral questionnaire. This will allow the college to see if there is anything else we need to put in place before we consider a referral.
2. If a referral to Neurodevelopmental Team at Navigo is deemed appropriate by the college then there are a number of different elements to the referral that need completing before the referral can be submitted.
3. Paperwork will be sent out to you - the young person to complete based around your own observations of yourself (the college can support you to complete this if required).
4. Paperwork will be sent out to your parent / carer to complete based around developmental and medical history and their observations of you (the college can support parents/ carers to complete this if required).
5. Paperwork will be completed by the College and your teachers based around their observations of you in an educational setting.

All this information needs completing before a referral can be sent off. This can take some time as the evidence required is quite comprehensive. College will collate all of the evidence and send off to Navigo.

You will need to have been a student at Franklin College for at least 6 months before we can consider referring you so that we are able to provide detailed observations.

Due to the demand for referrals, you will be put on a waiting list, and we will inform you as best as we can to when your referral will be actioned.

The Neurodevelopmental Team at Navigo endeavour to let you know within a 2-3 week period as to whether your referral has been successful to go onto their assessment waiting list.

Waiting times for assessment with Navigo fluctuate but are currently around 18 months.
