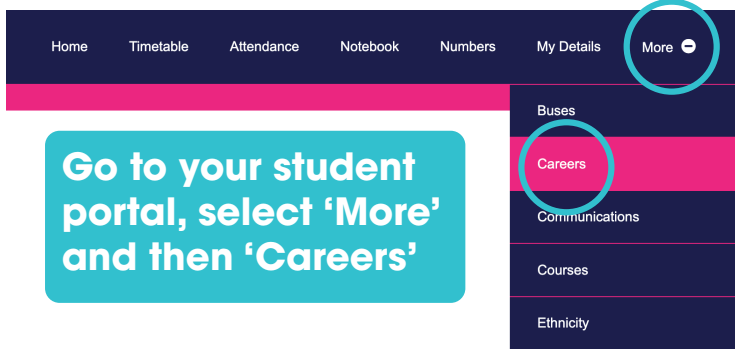
## **North East Lincolnshire Council Placements and Diana Princess of Wales Internships**
