

When troops get injured there's a team of highly skilled medical personnel on hand to help them recover. As a Physiotherapist Officer, you use your expertise to treat and rehabilitate service personnel with musculoskeletal injuries. You also advise commanders on injuries and training. During operations, you may deploy anywhere in the world. You could work with a MultiORole Medical Regiment (MMR) providing respiratory or critical care for wounded, injured or sick patients. The goal is to get our soldiers and officers fit and well, so we have an active, capable Army.

Although Bosch's terrifying visions of sin, death, and the hereafter may appear surreal today, especially his highly imaginative depictions of devils, they were tied to the religious attitudes and moralising texts of the period, such as the Ars Moriendi, the Dance of Death, and Everyman. It is in this context that one should examine Bosch's Haywain Triptych, Garden of Earthly Delights, and other works.

Sport & Fitness

If you're into playing sports or helping others, get active, this career path will always keep yo<mark>u on top of your game!</mark>

What is Sport and Fitness?

The Sports sector covers everything from athletes on the pitch to the people behind the scenes - trainers, organisers, and media pros - making sure sports events happen and everyone stays active. The fitness industry helps people smash their goals, whether that's getting stronger, fitter, or just staying healthy.

What are some of the jobs can I do?

- Athlete: Competes professionally or as an amateur, training full-time.
- Coach: Trains teams or individuals, creates workouts, and motivates athletes from beginners to professionals.
 - Event Manager: Organises sports events, manages logistics, ticketing, etc
- Personal Trainer: Provides one-on-one coaching to help clients achieve tailored health goals.
- Physiotherapist: Assists with injury recovery for athletes, aiding their return to peak performance.
- Sports Journalist: Reports on matches, interviews athletes, and creates content to update fans.

What are the top skills?

- **Initiative**: The ability to take charge and solve problems independently, crucial for fast-paced environments.
 - Leadership: Inspires and motivates teams, makes decisions, and guides others to achieve success.
- Physical Fitness: Essential for staying active and leading by example in sport and fitness roles.
- Problem Solving: Key for tackling challenges, from coaching to event management or setting
 fitness goals.
- Teamwork: Vital for working effectively with others, on the pitch or behind the scenes at events.

How do I start a career in Sport and Fitness?

- **Apprenticeships**: Options include Level 2 Community Activator Coach, Level 3 Personal Trainer, and Level 4 Sports Coach apprenticeships, combining work and training in sport and fitness.
 - University: A degree in sports science, nutrition, or physiotherapy can lead to careers in coaching, healthcare, or sports management.
 - **Postgraduate Qualifications**: A master's in sports science, physiotherapy, or management helps you specialise and advance your career.
- **Stand Out**: Gain hands-on experience through volunteering, coaching, or internships to build skills and demonstrate passion for sport and fitness.
