



So you want a career as an Operating Department Practitioner?

Operating Department Practitioners (ODPs) are an essential part of a surgical team. As an ODP, you'll take care of patients, prepare the operating theatre and surgical equipment, and act as a vital link between the surgical team, other hospital departments, and patients.

If you're thinking about studying for a degree in ODP, book your place to explore:

- Typical ODP courses at university and what they involve, including our accredited degree at Portsmouth, where you'll gain hands-on, NHS experience.

Mathematical Puzzles and Paradoxes Lecture with Gresham College

Many puzzles have a long history, such as water pouring puzzles, where you need to measure (for example) one pint of water equipped only with an eight-pint and a five-pint jug. The mathematics behind the solution has many useful applications.

Meanwhile, paradoxes such as: "some men shave themselves; those that do not shave themselves are shaved by the barber: who shaves the barber?" lead us to deep questions about set theory. In this lecture, Professor Sarah Hart will discuss several examples and the related mathematics.
