

Year 13s - register to vote by tomorrow!

Prime Minister Rishi Sunak made a surprise announcement to call a general election on 4th July 2024. A general election is when the public votes on who they want their MP to be — this is the person who represents your local area in Parliament. Most people who stand will represent a political party, and the Conservatives have been in power for 14 years. Even though this election is happening in just a few weeks' time, there is still time for you to register to vote!

Voting means that you can have an influence over issues which affect your local community – including resources allocated to educational providers and local job opportunities. You have until 11:59pm on 28th June 2024 to register to vote, and **you must be 18 by the day of**the election to vote.





Health & Safety

Being a health and safety professional is all about preventing injury and ill-health, so if you have a caring nature then this career could be for you. In the UK, employers must abide by the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 which is all about preventing harm in the workplace and potentially saving lives.

What jobs are available?

There is a large variety of health and safety-related jobs and can often vary in title and description as well as industry. Entry-level roles could be administrative or coordinator positions but a health and safety career could help you progress all the way to Director level. Roles include:

- Health and safety professionals working to reduce accidents, injury and health problems in the workplace.
- QHSE professionals some are also responsible for quality and environmental management.
 - Building Safety Regulatory Lead Determine the level of inspection the property requires, including site visits.
 - Fire safety professionals provide fire safety advice and establish an effective fire safety management system.
- You could choose to work 'in-house' for an organisation or, as you become more experienced, you could set up your own consultancy practice.

What Health & Safety Qualifications are available?

NEBOSH – the National Examination Board in Occupational Health and Safety - offers qualifications that are taken my many thousands of health and safety professionals – and those aspiring to be one – from across the world every year.

Qualifications range from introductory Awards, all the way up to Masters level, as well as specialist qualifications in topics such as construction, fire safety and workplace stress. Those who achieve NEBOSH's higher level qualifications are also invited to an annual Graduation celebration.
