





Legal Apprenticeships and Work Experience

Solicitor Apprenticeship

- The Solicitor Apprenticeship is a 6-year, level 7 degree apprenticeship programme.
- Solicitor Apprentices spend 4 days working with their team in the office and have 1 dedicated study day per week.
- Solicitor Apprentices will gain a fully sponsored LLB in Legal Practice and Skills. In addition, they work towards and then sit the Solicitors Qualifying Exam (SQE).
- Upon successful completion, subject to SRA Character & Suitability assessment, apprentices will become a qualified solicitor and be eligible to apply for Newly Qualified Solicitor roles.
- Solicitor Apprentices work on client projects along with experienced colleagues who provide regular mentoring & feedback.
- Apprentices can expect to get involved in client meetings, assist solicitors with legal matters, conduct legal research and draft legal correspondence and documents. As apprentices progress in the programme, they are introduced to more advanced tasks.
- Solicitor Apprentices receive comprehensive training & development throughout the apprenticeship.
- Solicitor Apprentices are supported by a supervisor, who will be an experienced solicitor, as well as a dedicated early talent team. Apprentices have an apprentice buddy to help them settle into both working and studying.

- If you don't meet the minimum academic criteria but you have mitigating circumstances, we will take this into account.

Paralegal Apprenticeship

- A Paralegal Apprenticeship is a 2-year, level 3 apprenticeship programme.
- Paralegal Apprentices spend 4 days working in the office with 1 dedicated study day per week.
- Pinsent Masons partner with an experienced training provider and apprentices can access ongoing support.
- Paralegal Apprentices can expect a wide variety of work, including administrative and legal tasks. Legal work will include helping to manage the documentation required in legal matters, including creating bundles of documents that will be used in court; drafting of legal documents such as contracts, settlement agreements and legal correspondence; legal research; taking minutes and writing up notes for meetings or legal proceedings.
- Excellent training and networking opportunities are available throughout the apprenticeship programme. Apprentices will study a range of legal modules and regularly undertake team specific training.
- The current starting salary for the Paralegal Apprenticeship is £22,950.
- Upon successful completion of a Paralegal Apprenticeship, individuals could have the opportunity to apply for Paralegal roles. Alternatively depending on role availability and individual preference, you could also apply for our Solicitor Apprenticeship programme.

If you are successful in securing a Pinsent Masons Solicitor Apprenticeship following completion of our Paralegal Apprenticeship, the duration of the Solicitor Apprenticeship may be shortened.

The academic requirements for the Paralegal Apprenticeship are:

- Minimum 5 GCSEs (or equivalent qualification), including Maths and English, at grade C or 4 or above.
- Minimum 3 A-levels at grade C or above (obtained or predicted), or an equivalent qualification amounting to 96 UCAS points.
- If you don't meet the minimum academic criteria but you have mitigating circumstances, we will take this into account.

Access to Sheffield with University of Sheffield

The University of Sheffield runs the **Access to Sheffield programme** for Year 12 and 13 students, designed to give a real taste of university life and help with decisions about higher education. There are five subject pathways to choose from—Arts & Humanities, STEM, Medicine, Dentistry, and Law—each including workshops, campus visits, summer schools, and guidance with UCAS applications. All participants benefit from skills-building activities, optional mentoring from current undergraduates, and free access to online study resources. The programme is aimed at students who meet widening participation criteria (such as being the first in their family to attend university, receiving free school meals, or having experience of care) and who are on track to meet the academic requirements for their chosen pathway. Completing the programme can also lead to a reduced ("contextual") offer for a place at the University of Sheffield.
