Year 13s – register to vote!

Prime Minister Rishi Sunak made a surprise announcement to call a general election on 4th July 2024. A general election is when the public votes on who they want their MP to be – this is the person who represents your local area in Parliament. Most people who stand will represent a political party, and the Conservatives have been in power for 14 years. Even though this election is happening in just a months' time, there is still time for you to register to vote!

Voting means that you can have an influence over issues which affect your local community – including resources allocated to educational providers and local job opportunities. You have until 11:59pm on 28th June 2024 to register to vote, and **you must be 18 by the day of the election to vote.**

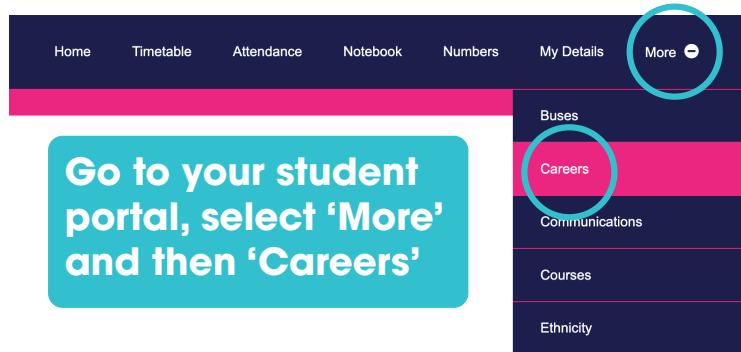

Locating Queer History with Gresham College

Queer urban life has changed dramatically in England over the last seventy years. Shifts in the economy, culture, attitudes, and technology have all played their part in this. London has often been used as the barometer for these shifts, suggesting they were experienced in similar ways across the nation.

In an exploration of the queer contours of Leeds, Manchester, Brighton and Plymouth, this lecture takes issue with this assumption and shows how and why LGBTQ scenes, communities and identities could feel very different from place to place. This webinar is hosted by Professor Matt Cook, a Professor in the History of Sexuality at Oxford University. He is a cultural historian specializing in British queer history in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.

Sport & Fitness

For every professional athlete that steps out onto the field, there are scores of other people supporting them to train and keep healthy. And, from the journalists who bring us close-up shots of the action to the organisers and managers getting spectators in their seats, there are plenty of people making sure that the spotlight shines on sport. Many careers in sport & fitness also focus on promoting healthier lifestyles and sports more widely amongst the general public. These roles are essential in making sure that people everywhere have access to sports facilities and the knowledge to train and stay fit.

What jobs are available?

There are many jobs available in sport and fitness! Just a few of these jobs include athletes, coaches, club/event managers, instructors, nutritionists, outdoor activity leaders, personal trainers, physiotherapists, sports development officers, sports journalists and presenters – and so many more!

Entry routes and training

Athlete - To become a pro athlete, you will need to get training. Once you know the sport you want to do, whether it's tennis, football, or motor racing, join a local club and start competing. All professional football clubs run development programmes or academies for young people to train and they often scout around local clubs for talent. You could also take a level 3 advanced apprenticeship as a sporting excellence professional.

Coaching - If you are interested in coaching / instructing / personal training, you will need some vocational qualifications after GCSE. You could do a higher apprenticeship as a sports coach.

Other roles - Teachers, nutritionists and physiotherapists will need a vocational degree in their chosen subject plus some on the job training.

Note: To work with young people (under 18) you will need to have a background check from the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) before you start any job or volunteer role.

What sport and fitness qualifications are available?

All instructor, coaching and sports development jobs offer the chance to work towards NVQs and QCF qualifications up to level four in a range of areas, from working with disabled people to sports leadership. You can also gain qualifications and complete career development through the Chartered Institute for the Management of Sport and Physical Activity (CIMSPA).
