Please check your Google Classroom for details on meeting your Career Academy teacher. Finally, if you do not have a skills log, please collect one from the CfPD office.





## Mechanical Fitter Apprentice with Quartzelec Ltd, Grimsby

## **Dixon Wilson Tax Apprenticeship Scheme**

You will start with study towards the ATT (Association of Taxation Technicians), followed by further studies towards CTA (Chartered Tax Adviser) the highest-level tax qualification in the UK. The ATT and CTA qualifications form a four-year Level 4 & 7 apprenticeship programme with Dixon Wilson.

Dixon Wilson pay all the costs for professional exams, including tuition courses, study manuals, textbooks, and examination fees for the first sitting. During the tax apprenticeship scheme, trainees will receive paid study leave to attend the tuition courses and exams.
