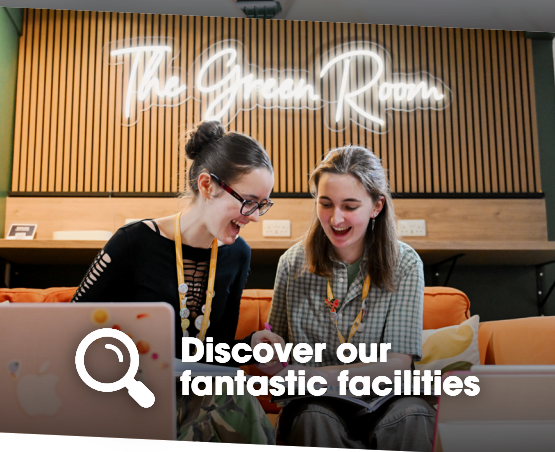

Lunch is pizza and a drink! There is a vegan option available for those with dietary needs. You're welcome to bring your own lunch if you'd prefer.

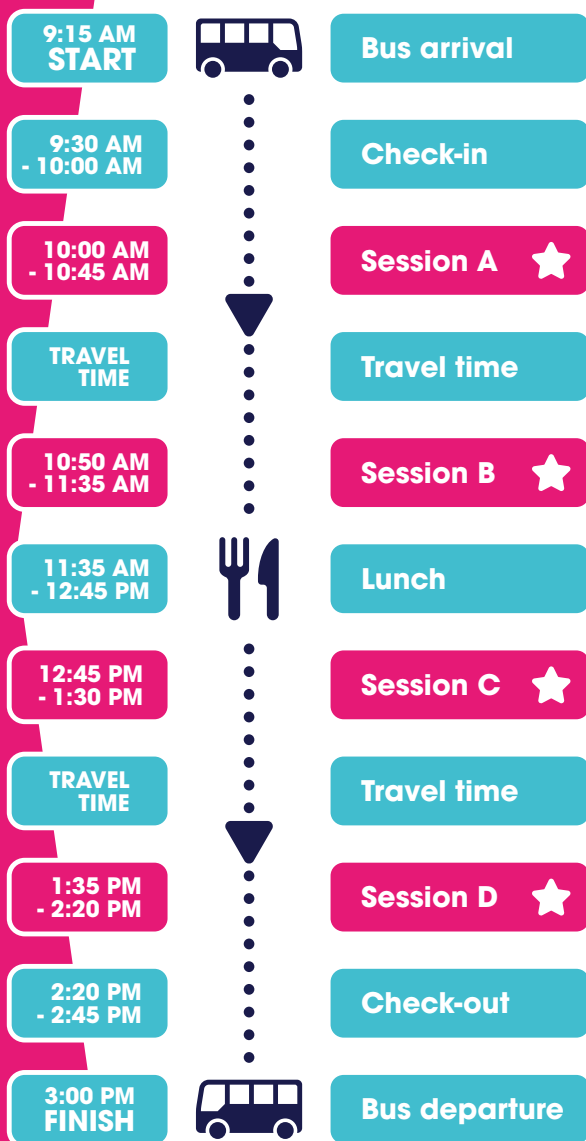

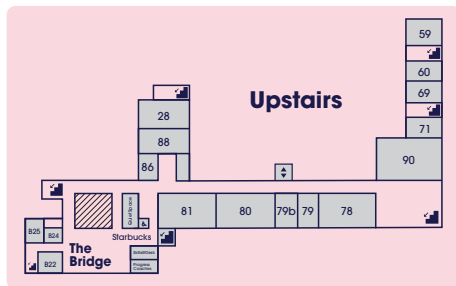
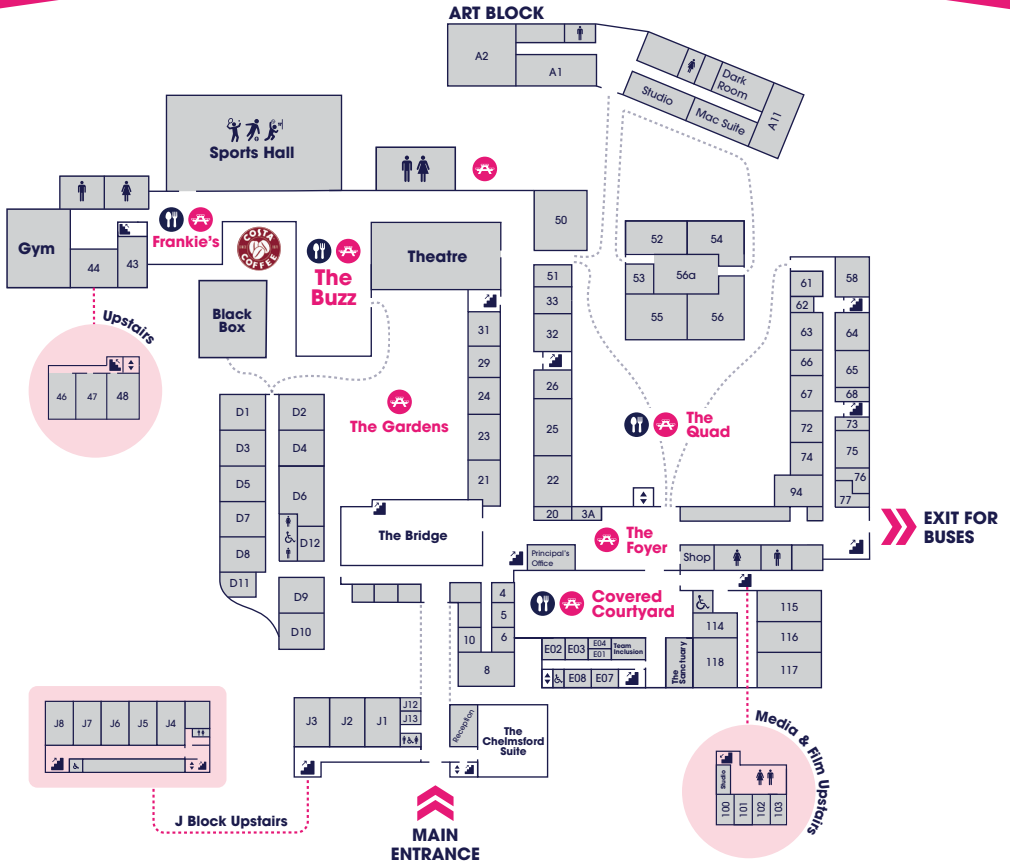
