This competition invites 16- to 18-year-olds to submit essays of up to 1,200 words addressing the question: "Does free speech build or break a community?".

Submissions are due by March 31 2025, and the winner will receive a £500 cash prize and have their work published on The Holocaust Listening Project.

Matias has continued with this project whilst he studies and works in the UK, he is now trying to promote the project so that he can make another donation for Christmas.





Insurance & Pensions

Feeling flush today? Awesome! But let's not forget about tomorrow. Start a career in insurance and pensions and help others plan for their future, too!

What is insurance and pensions?

Insurance is all about protecting your favourite stuff – like your car, home or even a celeb's iconic legs! If things go south, insurance helps you bounce back financially. Pensions are your retirement money goals. You and your employer stash some cash into a fund while you work, so when you retire, you can chill with regular income. Both insurance and pensions are about smart money management for the long haul. Insurance companies often do both, investing your pension cash and covering you when life throws curveballs.

What jobs can I do?

- Asset Manager: Asset managers are the money wizards. They invest your insurance premiums
 and pension funds to make that cash grow. Basically, they're all about making smart moves
 with your money.
 - Claims Inspector: Claims inspectors are like detectives for insurance claims. They dig into accidents, check records, and make sure people aren't pulling a fast one when they cash in a claim.
- Insurance Broker: Insurance brokers are your go-to experts for finding the best insurance deals.
 They know how to read the small print and make sure you're getting the coverage you actually need.
- **Pension Scheme Manager:** Pension scheme managers handle the company's pension funds. They develop policies, advise on investments, and ensure there's enough cash when employees retire. They've got your back for the future!
- **Underwriter:** Underwriters are the gatekeepers of insurance applications. They decide who gets coverage based on the risk factor and set the terms of your policy. No risk, no reward!

What are the top skills?

- Attention-to-detail: Catching small mistakes to avoid bigger issues later.
- Communication: Explaining complex policies and negotiating deals clearly.
 - Logical thinking: Analysing data and situations to find the best solutions.
- Numerical skills: Using data for smart financial decisions in areas like asset management.
- Problem-solving: Creative thinking to handle challenges such as claims or insurance plans.

How do I start a career in insurance and pensions?

- Can I do an apprenticeship? You can start with a level 2 apprenticeship, such as accounts or finance assistant, and progress to a level 6 financial services professional.
- **Is uni an option?** Yes! A degree in finance, economics, or business management is great for roles like actuary or asset manager.
- **How can I stand out?** Join challenges like the UK Maths Challenge or solve logic puzzles to boost your skills and make your CV stand out.

If you're looking to submit your UCAS application by the 29 January 2025 equal consideration deadline, then you have the option to leave your 5th UCAS choice empty, so that you can add this course to your application at a later date.

Children, smart phones and risk: examining the debate - Sociology at University of Reading

The rising use of technology has been hugely beneficial for many aspects of everyday lives, but issues of potential risk and harm have also been raised, particularly in relation to childhood. In the UK, a group of parents has put forward a campaign for 'Smart Phone Free Childhood', asking parents to sign a pact to withhold smartphones from children until they reach 14. Key questions can be identified around balancing children's agency with parents' concerns about risk and online safety including cyberbullying and children's mental health.

Participants will be guided to understand different positions within the debate, apply sociological concepts and ideas to diverse perspectives, before taking part in a final vote at the end of the session.
